ADMISSION OF FOREIGN NATIONALS IN BANGLADESH UNIVERSITY OF ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY (BUET) AT UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2017-2018

1. The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has offered a number of seats in the undergraduate programme of Bangladesh University of Engineering & Technology (BUET) for foreign students for the session **2017-2018**. Applicants who passed the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examination or its equivalent in **2016** or later/ GCE "A" level examination after **November 2015** or later are eligible to apply, subject to fulfilment of other conditions.

2. **Eligibility criteria**

- (a) Foreign nationals having their Higher Secondary Examination (HSE) or its equivalent examination from foreign education boards/ GCE 'A' or its equivalent education in foreign countries shall be considered as 'foreign' students.
- (b) Candidates must have passed Higher Secondary or its equivalent examination with minimum "A" grades or 70% marks in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English. If the transcript contains both letter and numerical grades, then the letter grade will be considered.
- (c) Candidates passing the GCE 'O' level and GCE 'A' level must earn minimum of "B" grade in at least five subjects (including Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English) in GCE 'O' level examination and minimum of "A" grades in the three subjects of Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry in GCE "A" level examination.
- (d) Candidates willing to be enrolled in Biomedical Engineering Department must have obtained a minimum of "A" grade or 70% marks in Biology in the Higher Secondary or its equivalent examination or a minimum of "B" grade in GCE "A" level or its equivalent examination.

3. **Number of seats.** The total number of seats for foreign students in undergraduate program in a single academic session is 26 (twenty six). However, a maximum of 10 (ten) students from a single country and a maximum of 05 (Five) students in a single department shall be allowed.

4. **Procedure for submission of application.** Applications of Indian students for admission **must be submitted through the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India** to the **Deputy High Commission for the People's Republic of Bangladesh, 9 Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Sarani, Kolkata-700017 by 04 December 2017.** The relevant documents of educational qualifications and 4 (four) recently taken colour photographs of the candidate should be included with the application form. After receiving the applications, the Admission Committee will select the eligible candidates for Admission in order of merit.

5. **Cost of Study.** The tuition and other fees for undergraduate studies for students from SAARC countries will be charged as per regulations of Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh. The students from non-SAARC countries will be charged US\$ 200 (two hundred) for admission fee and US\$ 50 (Fifty) per credit hour as course registration fee.
